

## **TENNESSEE'S POLICY REGARDING OVERWEIGHT VEHICLES IN A HURRICANE EMERGENCY**

Tennessee Department of Transportation will accommodate vehicles transporting FEMA supplies and equipment as well as temporary housing.

In Tennessee, no permits are required for transporting temporary housing for FEMA. Transporters will only need FEMA papers and the FEMA banner. To better accommodate FEMA housing needs, TDOT is allowing transport on Sundays and at night depending on the urgency.

Permits will still be required for transporting FEMA supplies and equipment. Safety must still be considered for the infrastructure. This includes physical weight and vertical restrictions (i.e.: transporting tall transformers under low clearance bridges).
