Project Description

The Ohio Department of Transportation's DriveOhio project in collaboration with the Indiana Department of Transportation and multiple government, industry and education partners will advance the deployment and adoption of truck automation technologies by the logistics industry. The technologies will be integrated into daily revenue service operations that use the I-70 corridor to deliver products across Ohio and Indiana. The I-70 Truck Automation Corridor program truck automation deployments will serve as a model, using audits and outreach, to determine the readiness of other interstates in the two states for future deployments.
